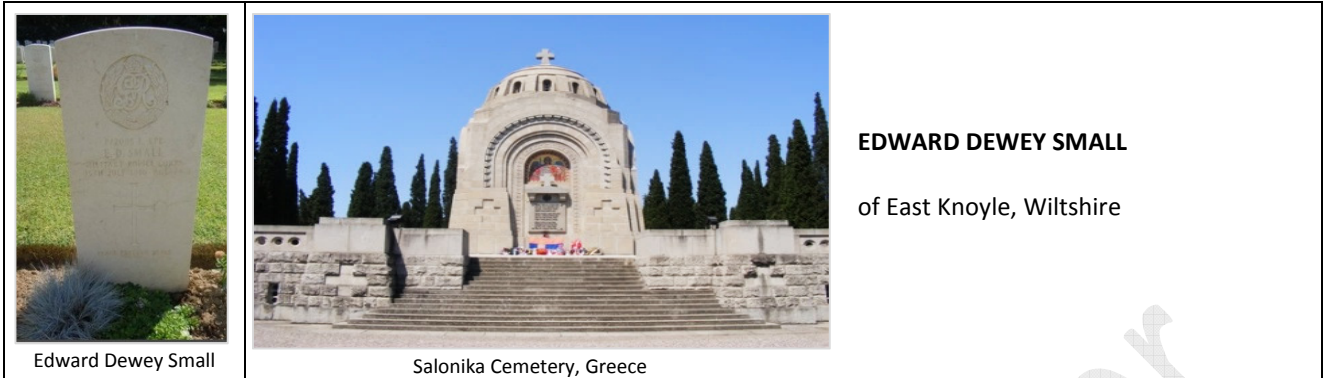

L/Cpl Edward Small died in Salonika having completed less than 12 months service.

It is likely he died of disease, such as malaria. His headstone bears the inscription "Peace, perfect peace"
