

Removal Order for John & Alice Smith 1815
from East Knoyle to Semley

(TO WIT.) } To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of *East Knoyle* in the County of *wilts* aforesaid, to remove and convey; and to the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of *Semley* in the said County of *wilts* — to receive and obey. These.

WHEREAS Complaint hath been made by you the Church wardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of *East Knoyle* in the County of *wilts* aforesaid, unto us, whose Hands and Seals are hereunto subscribed and set, being two of His Majesty's Justices of the Peace acting in and for the said County (one whereof is of the Quorum) that *John Smith and Alice his wife* are

come to inhabit in the said Parish of *East Knoyle* not having gained a legal Settlement there, nor produced any Certificate, owning them or either of them — to be settled elsewhere; and that the said *John Smith and Alice his wife* are

actually become chargeable to the said Parish of *East Knoyle* — We, the said Justices, upon due Proof made thereof before us, as well as upon Examination of the said *John Smith* — upon Oath, as otherwise; and likewise, upon due Consideration had of the Premises, do adjudge the said Complaint and Premises to be true; and we do also adjudge, that the lawful Settlement of them — the said *John Smith and Alice his wife*

is in the said Parish of *Semley* in the County of *wilts* aforesaid.

THESE are therefore, in His Majesty's Name, and by Virtue of the Statutes in this Behalf made, to order and require you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of *East Knoyle* — or some or one of you, to remove and convey the said *John Smith and Alice his wife*

from and out of your said Parish of *East Knoyle* — to the said Parish of *Semley* — and them deliver to the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor there, or to some or one of them, together with this our Warrant or Order, or a true Copy thereof. And we do also hereby require you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of

Semley forthwith to receive the said *John Smith and Alice his wife*

into your said Parish, and provide for them — as your own Parishioner — GIVEN under our Hands and Seals, the *Nineteenth* Day of *December* in the Year of our Lord 1815.
