

*Removal Order for John & Hannah Scammell 1794
from East Knoyle to Sedgemoor*

Wicks to wit } To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of
East Knoyle } in the County
of Wilt } and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of Sedgemoor
in the said County of Wilt } to convey, and to the Churchwarden
to receive. } THESE.

WHEREAS Complaint hath been made by you the Church-
wardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of
East Knoyle

unto us, whose Hands and Seals are hereunto set, two of his Ma-
jesty's Justices of the Peace (whereof one is of the Quorum) for the
County of Wilt afore said, That *John Scammell*
Hannah his Wife and his five Children nam-
ed *Edward* aged about 18 years, *Elizabeth* aged about 14 years,
Edward aged about 9 years, *Lucy* aged about 2 years
and *Sarah* aged about one year
lately intruded themselves into your said Parish of *East*
Knoyle there to inhabit
as — Parishioners contrary to the Laws relating to the Settlement of
the Poor, and are respectively to become chargeable to the
said Parish of *East Knoyle* And whereas upon due
Examination and Enquiry made into the Premises, it was
upon the Oath of the said John Scammell
it appears unto us, and we accordingly adjudge, that the said
John Scammell Hannah his Wife and
his said five Children are there likely to
become chargeable unto the said Parish of *East Knoyle*
and that the last legal Place of Settlement of the said
John Scammell Hannah his Wife
and his said five Children

was and is in the Parish of *Sedgemoor* in the said
County of Wilt

These are therefore, in his Majesty's Name, to order and require you
the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Parish of
East Knoyle afore said, That you, or some of you,
do forthwith remove and convey the said *John Scammell*
Hannah his Wife and his said five
Children

from your said Parish of *East Knoyle*
to the said Parish of *Sedgemoor*
and deliver to the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor
there, or some or one of them, together with this our Warrant or
Order, or a true Copy thereof: Whereby they are likewise re-
quired, in his Majesty's Name, and by Virtue of the Statutes in
such Case made, forthwith to receive the said *John Scammell*
Hannah his Wife and his said five Children
into their said Parish and provide for them
as their own Parishioners Given under our Hands and Seals,
the *10th* Day of *February* in the Year of
our Lord, 1794/5
