WHEREAS Complaint hath been made by you the Churchwardens and Overseers
of the Poor of the Parish of *East Knoyle*
in the County of *Wilt* aforsaid, unto us, whose
Hands and Seals are hereunto subscribed and set, being two of His Majesty's Justices
of the Peace acting in and for the said County (one
whereof is of the Quorum) that *Charles Ricketts and Mary
his wife are*

come to inhabit in the said Parish of *East Knoyle*
not having gained a legal Settlement there, nor produced any Certificate, owing
them to be settled elsewhere; and that
the said *Charles Ricketts and Mary his wife*
are

actually become chargeable to the said Parish of
us, as well as upon Examination of the said *Charles Ricketts* upon
Oath, as otherwise; and likewise, upon due Consideration had of the Premises, do
adjudge the said Complaint and Premises to be true; and we do also adjudge, that the
lawful Settlement of *them* the said *Charles Ricketts and
Mary his wife is*
is in the said Parish of *Sedgell* in the County of *Wilt*
aforsaid.

this Behalf made, to order and require you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of
the Poor of the said Parish of *East Knoyle* or some or one of you,
to remove and convey the said *Charles Ricketts and Mary
his wife*
from and out of your said Parish of *East Knoyle* to the said
Parish of *Sedgell* and *them* deliver to the
Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor there, or to some or one of them, together
with this our Warrant or Order, or a true Copy thereof. And we do also hereby
require you the said Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the said Parish of
Sedgell
forthwith to receive the said *Charles Ricketts and Mary
his wife*
into your said Parish, and provided for *them* as your own
