Letter from the Rector 1850

Ralph Ord was the Rector of Semley from 1812-1856. He wrote to Mr. William Pike of Semley congratulating him on his recent marriage and discusses the renting of Glebe Farm in the village

> To Mr. Wm Pike junior Temley 4. May 1850 My Dear Sir my house, two days ago, had not the pleasure to offer you my Congratulation of good wisher on your late marriage not informed of the happy State, to which you had been admitted. I beg my kind Wisker to more W. Pike on the Occapion. This Movning I have Jeen Mr. Rutter - & states your wish to have an offer made to your Father of yourself of my flede farm - which her Vincent

quits at New Michaelman next- about next hidnesday or Thursday you would be likely to meet with one or both M. Rutter's at their Office. We quantity held by M. Vincent & now to be let at Michaelman_ 4 96 1/2 awn - This quantity has been let at the vent of \$150 - per ann - in my time. and Mr. Scott 7 years ago held it at \$145 - yearly rental. and £. 135 was, till lash year, the rent paid by me Vincent - H M. Vincent has Catchy been Cowered to \$.115. The same form was held by Mr. miles at £100. M. Rutter has by him a Copy of the agreement or terms, on which An Vincent held the 96 dynaver.
