All Saints Chapel, New Wardour Castle

1738-1948



The marriage announcements below have been extracted from historic newspapers. It should not be presumed that these are the only marriages at the Chapel in the years shown or that there were none in the years not shown.

- 1738** Last Monday the Hon Mr Arundell, eldest son to the Right Hon the Lord Arundel, of Wardour, was married at Wardour Castle, in the County of Wilts, to Miss Arundell Belling, an Heiress of 30,000/. fortune

- 1785** Thursday last, at Wardour-castle, by special licence, James Everard Arundel, Count of the Sacred Roman Empire, eldest son of the Hon James Everard Arundel, of Ashcombe in the county of Dorset, to the Hon Miss Arundel, Countess of the Sacred Roman Empire, eldest daughter of the Right Hon Lord Arundel. The ceremony was performed by the Rev Mr Smith, his Lordship's curate of Ansty

- 1827** By special licence on the 26th of June at Wardour Castle, the seat of the Right Hon Lord Arundell (having been previously married at the Catholic Chapel by the Right Reverend Dr Weld) Edward Doughty Esq of Snarford Hall and West Barkworth in the county of Lincoln, second son of the late, and brother to the present Sir Henry Tichborne, Bart, of Tichborne House in the county of Hants, to the Hon Miss Katherine Arundell, youngest daughter of the late and sister to the present Lord Arundell.

- 1934** The marriage took place at the Church of All Saints, Wardour, on Thursday, of Miss Winifred Gurd, youngest daughter of Mr Frederick Gurd, Sans-lane, Donhead St Andrew, and Mr Frederick Charles Gray, second son of Mr and Mrs Frederick Gray, Barker's Hill, Donhead St Andrew. The Rev Father Keeble officiated. (part article only).
- 1935** The marriage was solemnised at Wardour Catholic Church yesterday (Thursday) morning of Flight-Lieut Fagan, R.A.F., Old Sarum, only son of the late Mr Fagan, of Castle Pollard, County West Meath, Ireland, and the Hon Isabel Arundell, younger daughter of Lord and Lady Arundell of Wardour.

- The British Ambassador to Lisbon, Sir Charles J F R Wingfield, gave away his only daughter, Miss Diana Wingfield, at her marriage yesterday (Thursday) afternoon at the Catholic Chapel at Wardour Castle, to Baron Alexandro Corsi di Turri, of Rome, a Captain in the Italian Royal Navy.

- 1937** The marriage was solemnised at All Saints Church, Wardour, on Boxing-day, of Mr Patrick L Haines, of Fonthill Gifford, and Miss Violet Mabel R Woods, eldest daughter of Mr and Mrs Charles Woods, of Hazeldon, Wardour (part article only).

- 1939** The marriage was solemnised at All Saints Church, Wardour on Saturday, of Miss Marie E Burt, only daughter of Mr and Mrs F Burt, of Bridzor Farm, Wardour, and Mr A G Bell, eldest son of the late Mr G Bell (Metropolitan Police) and Mrs Bell, of Upper Clatford, Andover. (part article only)
Western Gazette Friday 08 September 1939
- 1943** The wedding took place at All Saints R.C. Church, Wardour, of Miss Edith Vera Irene Dunn, twin daughter of Mr and Mrs Dunn, of Tisbury Gates, and Private Leslie James Ranger, eldest son of Mrs Ranger, Duck-street, Tisbury. The Rev Father Hyland officiated. The bride, given away by her father, wore a white satin gown and an embroidered veil held in position with an orange blossom halo, and carried a bouquet of white carnations and fern. She was attended by her twin sister, Miss Betty Dunn, and Miss Maisie Yeates, a friend, wearing ankle-length blue satin dresses, trimmed with pink roses and halos and shoes to match and carrying pink tinted tulips. Miss Sheila Moakes, wore a gold satin ankle length dress and halo and shoes to match and carried a posy of mixed flowers. The Best Man was Mr A Sanger (brother in law of the bridegroom). As the bride left the church she was presented with a silver horseshoe and silver heart by her two little nephews. (part article only)

- 1944** The marriage took place at All Saints Church, Wardour, recently of Mr H Bartley, youngest son of Mrs Bartley, Motcombe, Dorset, and Miss Betty Dunn, twin daughter of Mr and Mrs Dunn of Tisbury Gates. Father Hickey officiated assisted by Father Alfonso, the organist being Mrs Louise Burt of Wardour. The bride, given away by her father, wore a gown of white satin with a veil held in position by a halo of orange blossom and carried a shower bouquet of pink carnations and trailing fern. She was attended by her four nieces. (part article only)
