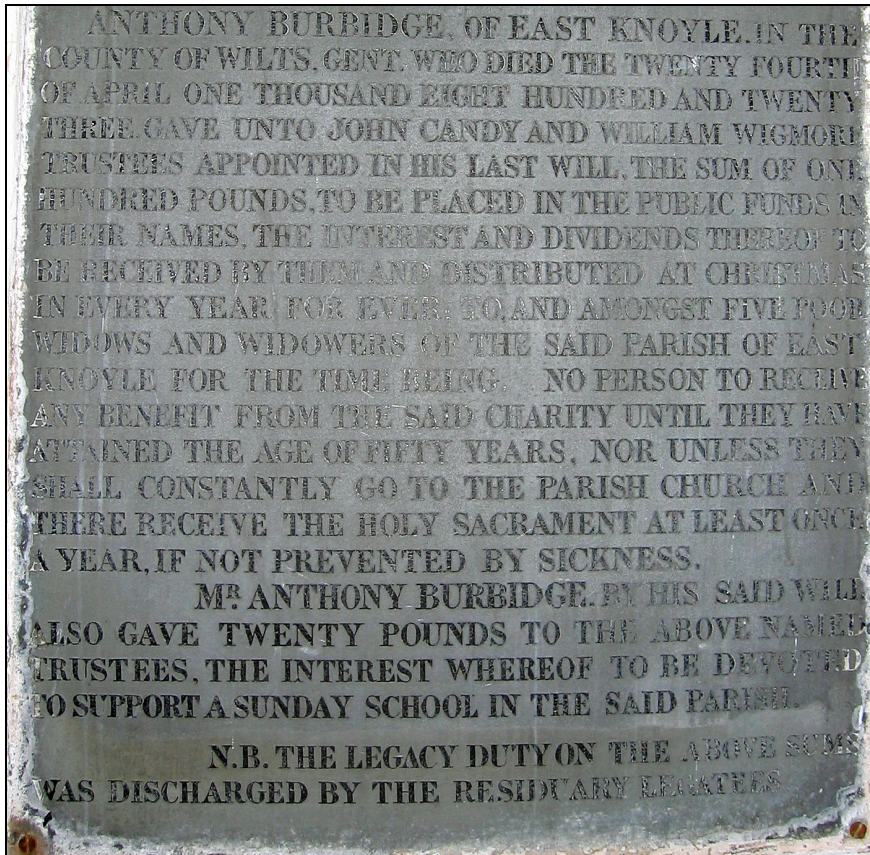


*St. Mary the Virgin Memorial
Legacy of Anthony Burbidge 1823*



Anthony Burbidge of East Knoyle, in the County of Wilts, Gent, who died the 24th of April One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Three, gave unto John Candy and William Wigmore, Trustees appointed in his last Will, the sum of One Hundred Pounds, to be placed in the public funds in their names, the interest and dividends thereof to be received by them and distributed at Christmas in every year for even to and amongst five poor widows and widowers of the said parish of East Knoyle for the time being. No person to receive any benefit from the said charity until they have attained the age of fifty years, nor unless they shall constantly go to the parish church and there receive the holy sacrament at least once a year, if not prevented by sickness.

Mr. Anthony Burbidge by his said Will also gave Twenty Pounds to the above named Trustees, the interest thereof to be devoted to support a Sunday School in the said parish.

N.B. The legacy duty on the above sum was discharged by the residuary legatees.
